

In June of 2017 she established the nonprofit Tools & Tiaras Inc. The organization's primary goals are threefold: *Expose, Inspire* and *Mentor* young girls and women about the highly lucrative field of construction. She's been featured at the 2017 Makers Conference, Megan Kelley Show and BBC's *The Conversation*.


