

NAWIC Membership Pins and the protocol behind them

The Official NAWIC Membership Pin



The emblem represents a woman holding a plumb bob with the name of the association between two concentric circles.

The Guards

*Pin Guards designate the member's current office,
or the highest office she attained.*

The President Guard



The office of the President is represented by a gavel.

The Vice President Guard



The office of the Vice President is represented by a torch.

The Recording Secretary (or Secretary) Guard



The office of the Secretary is represented by a quill.

The Corresponding Secretary Guard



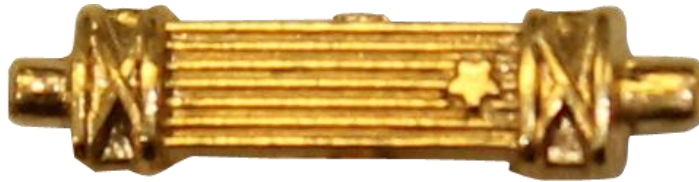
The office of the Corresponding Secretary is represented by a quill in an ink well.

The Treasurer Guard



The office of the Treasurer is represented by a key.

The Director Guard



The office of the Director is represented by a scroll.

The President Elect Guard



The office of the President Elect is represented by a gavel with the words "President Elect".

The Past President Guard



The office of the Past President is represented by a gavel with the words "Past President".

The Parliamentarian Guard



The office of the Parliamentarian is represented by a lion.

While not an elected officer, the parliamentarian is a vital part of the Board.
